<p>YCW “Watch Out, Help Out” Poster</p>		<p>This poster can be duplicated using a copy machine in color or in black and white. The Youth Crime Watch Recruitment Kit compact disc (CD) has an electronic version that you can open and print in color or in black and white using your computer (this applies to all of your kit’s contents).</p>
<p>YCWA “YOUth Can Make it Happen” Announcement Poster</p>		<p>This poster is a great tool for your Watch! If you have a message about a YCW meeting, a fundraiser, an event, or a safety tip that you would like to post in the halls of your school or community center, you can write it on this poster!</p> <p>For advanced computer users who would like to edit the poster using your computer software, you can scan the image into the software program of your choice. Then place text or images in the blank space to finish your poster!</p>
<p>“Watch Out, Help Out” Bookmarks</p>		<p>This page of bookmarks can be duplicated using a copy machine in color or in black and white. It is helpful to use a thick paper such as cardstock. Also, consider laminating your bookmarks by taking them to a local copy business. There are some laminating kits that you can buy from office supply stores as well.</p>
<p>“Ask Me About YCW” and “Youth Can Make it Happen” Buttons (2 ¼ inches)</p>		<p>This page of buttons can be duplicated using a copy machine in color or in black and white. They are designed to be used with a 2 ¼ inch pin-back button. This is the standard size button. 2 ¼ Inch button kits or button makers can be bought at office supply stores.</p> <p>Use the mylar disc (the clear plastic circle that comes with your button-making sets) to trace around the design. Cut carefully along the line of the circle you drew. Or, use a circle cutter for your 2 ¼ inch button design.</p>

<p>YCW “Ask Yourself Quiz”</p>		<p>This quiz is a great way for youth to learn some basic facts about youth and crime. Oftentimes, youth will be surprised by the answers. This quiz lists the sources of the facts, and it also encourages those taking the quiz to think more deeply about what they are learning.</p> <p>Make copies of this quiz using a copy machine. Or, print more using your computer from The Youth Crime Watch Recruitment Kit compact disc (CD).</p>
<p>YCW Pledge Cards</p>		<p>This sheet of pledge cards can be duplicated using a copy machine in color or in black and white. These are set up so you can make double-sided copies that will cut perfectly into six cards. When you make copies of the sheet, it is best if you use a heavy paper such as cardstock.</p> <p>Distribute these pledge cards to the members you recruit! Remember to ask them to write their name at the top and sign beneath the pledge. On the back, write in the name of your YCW site, the name of your advisor, and you advisor’s phone number.</p>
